- We set up programs through other organizations.

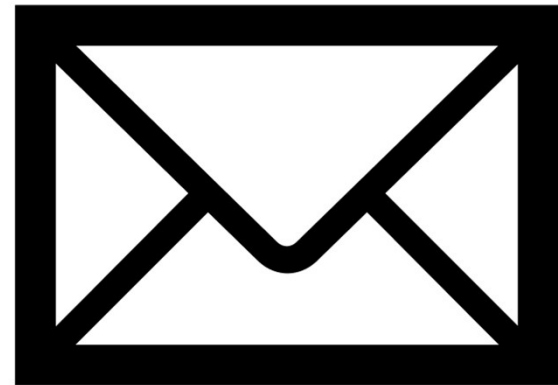
