# When Businesses Get the Support They Need Impact of Entrepreneur Support Organizations (ESOs) on Businesses 2024-2025 Grant Cycle



- 46 ESOs were funded during the WSMA 2024-2025 Statewide Grant Cycle
- ESO programs served entrepreneurs in every part of the state reaching 5,700+ companies including cooperatives with business training, technical assistance and support with accessing financing
- 52% of the entrepreneurs served throughout WA were BIPOC owned
- Businesses who received specific business financial training/technical assistance or support were able to access \$2,762,421 in financing,
- 646 jobs were created through the dedicated work of these Entrepreneur Support
   Organizations (ESOs)
